

Day 1 (October 5th): Isaiah 2:36

Come, let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of the God of Jacob; that He may teach us concerning His ways and that we may walk in His paths.

Pray for everyone who will “come” to the mountains and delight in Him.

Day 2 (October 6th): 1 John 2:27a

As for you, the anointing which you received from Him abides in you. . . .

Pray for the call of God in each woman’s life.

Day 3 (October 7th): 2 Corinthians 9:8

And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that always having all sufficiency in everything, you may have an abundance for every good deed.

Pray for God to confirm His call on each woman’s life by His Spirit.

Day 4 (October 8th): Proverbs 4:18

But the path of the righteous is like the light of dawn, that shines brighter and brighter until the full day.

Pray for each woman’s path to shine ever brighter as she follows her calling.

Day 5 (October 9th): Psalm 24:3-4a

Who may ascend into the hill of the LORD? And who may stand in His holy place? He who has clean hands and a pure heart. . . .

Pray for each of us to be repentant; for the purification of our hearts.

Day 6 (October 10th): Mark 6:31a

And He said to them, “Come away by yourselves to a secluded place and rest a while.”

Pray for those who are making major preparations for the conference to set aside special times of rest.

Day 7 (October 11th): Job 1:10a

Have You not made a hedge about him and his house and all that he has, on every side?

Pray for a hedge of protection over each woman’s life so that no one will be able to squelch what God has in store for her.

Day 8 (October 12th): 2 Corinthians 4:6

For God, who said, “Light shall shine out of darkness,” is the One who has shone in our hearts to give the Light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Christ

Pray for the lost family members of the women who are coming.

Day 9 (October 13th): Mark 4:39

And He got up and rebuked the wind and said to the sea, “Hush, be still.” And the wind died down and it became perfectly calm.

Pray for a calming of the stormy circumstances in the lives of all the women who are coming to the conference.

Day 10 (October 14th): Psalm 72:3

Let the mountains bring peace to the people, and the hills, in righteousness.

Pray for a peaceful atmosphere surrounding the resort, the town, and all lodging places.

Day 11 (October 15th): Job 23:10

But He knows the way I take; when He has tried me, I shall come forth as gold.

Pray for peace in God’s wisdom for our paths collectively and individually.

Day 12 (October 16th): Psalm 121:1-2

I will lift up my eyes to the mountains; from where shall my help come? My help comes from the LORD, Who made heaven and earth.

Pray for women to look to the Lord for their help concerning every detail of this conference.

Day 13 (October 17th): Matthew 5:6

Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied.

Pray for those women who are hungering and thirsting for more of God, that they would be filled.

Day 14 (October 18th): Jeremiah 29:12-13

Then you will call upon Me and come and pray to Me, and I will listen to you. You will seek Me and find Me when you search for Me with all your heart.

Pray for an increased prayer life for all PWOC women.

Day 15 (October 19th): Psalm 119:71

It is good for me that I was afflicted, that I may learn Your statutes.

Pray for workshop leaders and speakers as they learn from their times of trial and prepare to share God’s truths.

Day 16 (October 20th): Psalm 112:16

How blessed is the man who fears the LORD, who greatly delights in His commandments.

Pray for each woman to delight in God’s commands.

Day 17 (October 21st): Matthew 25:21

Well done, good and faithful slave. You were faithful with a few things, I will put you in charge of many things; enter into the joy of your master.

Pray for the outgoing PWOC-USA board.

Day 18 (October 22nd): Psalm 96:1-3

Sing to the LORD a new song; sing to the LORD, all the earth. Sing to the LORD, bless His name; proclaim good tidings of His salvation from day to day. Tell of His glory among the nations, His wonderful deeds among all the peoples.

Pray for Alicia Williamson and the worship team.

Day 19 (October 23rd): Psalm 30:5

For His anger is but for a moment, His favor is for a lifetime; weeping may last for the night, but a shout of joy comes in the morning.

Thank the Lord for His favor that lasts a lifetime and for His joy.

Day 20 (October 24th): Numbers 6:24-26

The LORD bless you, and keep you; the LORD make His face shine on you, and be gracious to you; the LORD lift up His countenance on you, and give you peace.

Pray the above scripture, Aaron’s priestly blessing, over each family.

Day 21 (October 25th): 2 Corinthians 1:20-22

For as many as are the promises of God, in Him they are yes; therefore also through Him is our Amen to the glory of God through us. Now He who establishes us with you in Christ and anointed us is God, who also sealed us and gave us the Spirit in our hearts as a pledge.

Pray for the incoming PWOC-USA board.

Day 22 (October 26th): Psalm 133

Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brothers to dwell together in unity! It is like the precious oil upon the head, coming down upon the beard, even Aaron's beard, coming down upon the edge of his robes. It is like the dew of Hermon coming down upon the mountains of Zion; for there the LORD commanded the blessing—life forever.

Pray for unity of the Sisters in PWOC.

Day 23 (October 27th): Lamentations 3:22-26

The LORD's lovingkindnesses indeed never cease, for His compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is Your faithfulness. "The LORD is my portion," says my soul, "Therefore I have hope in Him." The LORD is good to those who wait for Him, to the person who seeks Him. It is good that he waits silently for the salvation of the LORD.

Pray with gratefulness for God's patience with His impatient saints.

Day 24 (October 28th): Revelation 4:11

Worthy are You, our Lord and our God, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and because of Your will they existed, and were created.

Pray for God's purposes for PWOC to be revealed and carried out during the conference and beyond.

Day 25 (October 29th): I Corinthians 6:19-20

Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own? For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's.

Pray for all the women who have been chosen to serve God in the ministry of PWOC.

Day 26 (October 30th): Proverbs 16:3

Commit your works to the LORD And your plans will be established.

Pray for the works of PWOC.

Day 27 (October 31st): Psalm 127:1-2

Unless the LORD builds the house, they labor in vain who build it; unless the LORD guards the city, the watchman keeps awake in vain. It is vain for you to rise up early, to retire late, to eat the bread of painful labors; for He gives to His beloved even in his sleep.

Pray for the building of the PWOC ministry.

Day 28 (November 1st): Ecclesiastes 7:12

For wisdom is protection just as money is protection, but the advantage of knowledge is that wisdom preserves the lives of its possessors.

Pray for wisdom in the PWOC ministry.

Day 29 (November 2nd): Ezekiel 36:27

I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will be careful to observe My ordinances.


Pray for God's indwelling Spirit to abide in His chosen leaders for PWOC.
